

Minutes of the Regular
Scheduled Meeting
Troup City Council
May 19, 2014

A Scheduled Meeting of the Troup City Council was held Monday May 19, 2014 at 5:45 pm at the Cameron J-Jarvis Troup Municipal Library located at 102 S. Georgia, Troup, Texas. Councilpersons present were: Joe Carlyle, Gary Salyer, Chip Richardson and Mayor Pro Tem Carole Wilson. Also present were City Administrator Gene Cottle and City Secretary Buffie Deason.

Guest present were Pat Hendrix, Jerry Lacy, Kyle Stowers, and others not signed in.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson called the meeting to order at 5:48 p.m. noting all Council Persons were present with exception of Jeff Hale and Mayor John Whitsell.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson – Led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson – Item 4 Brief comments concerning non-agenda items. No comments noted.

Mayor Pro-Tem Carole Wilson- Canvass the results of the May 10, 2014 Election. Mayor – Bill Lacy 111 votes; John Whitsell 89 votes; Councilperson II – Joe Carlyle 153 votes; Councilperson V Carole Wilson 145 votes. City Secretary Buffie Deason certified that the canvass was correct as read. Councilperson Gary Salyer made the motion to canvass the vote for the May 10, 2014 election. Councilperson Chip Richardson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Bill Lacy was issued oath of office by City Secretary Buffie Deason for Mayor for the City of Troup. Mayor Lacy then took his set with Council.


Certificates of election were issued by City Manager Gene Cottle to Mayor Bill Lacy, Councilperson II Joe Carlyle, and Councilperson V Carole Wilson.

Mayor Bill Lacy – Discuss and consider the selection of Mayor Pro-Tem. Councilperson Joe Carlyle ask Councilperson Carole Wilson if she would like to continue with the position of Pro-tem, Mrs. Wilson agreed that she would. Councilperson Joe Carlyle made the motion to nominate Councilperson Carole Wilson to serve as Mayor Pro-Tem. Councilperson Chip Richardson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Lacy – Item 15 Comments and input from Council, Mayor, Or City Manager concerning items of interest or items for a future agenda. City Manager Gene Cottle ask the Councilmembers their opinion on moving the Council Meeting to the library, instead of having them at the school. Mr. Cottle told Council that for convenience it would be easier for himself and City Secretary Buffie Deason. Council agreed that the meeting should be held at the Cameron J-Jarvis Troup Municipal Library.
